THOUGHT FOR PENTECOST (4/5th June): An advocate is someone you call on to be by your side, someone who represents you and takes up your cause. At Pentecost we celebrate the fact that Jesus has not gone to his Father to leave us as orphans but has sent the Holy Spirit as our Advocate. On this birthday of the Church we pledge ourselves to allow the Spirit of God to enter our hearts and to work in our lives.



1st Reading: (Acts 2:1-11). St. Luke describes the descent of the Holy Spirit on the apostles, and the effect it had on them.

2nd Reading: (1 Cor 12:3-7.12-13). The Holy Spirit gives different gifts to different people, for the good of the Church, the Body of Christ.

Gospel: (In 20:19-23). The risen Jesus gives the gift of the Holy Spirit to his disciples and inaugurates the mission of the Church.

THOUGHT FOR TRINITY SUNDAY (11/12th June): The words of today's gospel are an echo of the promises fulfilled last week at Pentecost. Only in the power of the Holy Spirit can we begin to approach the mystery which is the Trinity. Even then, we approach it not so that we can ever understand it, but so that we may stand in awe as we worship Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

1st Reading: (Prov 8:22-31). This reading in praise of the wisdom of God can be seen as a struggle towards the revelation of the mystery of the Trinity.

2nd Reading: (Rom 5:1-5). Christ made possible for us a loving relationship with God. This gives us the hope and sustains us in time of suffering.

Gospel: (Jn 16:12-15). The Holy Spirit helps the Church to grasp the full meaning of all Jesus said, especially what he said about the Father.


