we naturally feel sorry for Martha when Jesus visits her home, Jesus is pointing out that Mary has learnt what really matters while Martha is content with busying herself. Do we have time in our busy schedules just to entertain God?



First Reading: (Gen 18:1-10). When Abraham gave hospitality to three strangers he did not know that he was entertaining God Himself, who would reward him with good news.

Second Reading: (Col 1:24-28). Paul, a minister of the good news of the calling of the Gentiles to salvation, suffers for his converts.

Gospel: (Lk 10:38-42). The Gospel contrasts Martha's activity and Mary's quiet devotion to the Lord.

THOUGHT FOR 17th SUNDAY OF THE YEAR (23rd/24th July):

The Lord's Prayer, taught to the disciples by Jesus, is not simply a formula. It is a model of how all our prayer should be. If God knows all our needs, even before we make our requests, then we should be confident that nothing we really need will be denied us when we call upon God. The thing is to know what we really need.


