THOUGHT FOR EASTER SUNDAY (30th/31st March): Just three ALLEALVIA small words sum up what we celebrate at Easter: water, light and life. Our thirst for God is quenched by the promises of baptism, our darkness is dispelled by the light of the Easter fire and the flame of the paschal candle, and the newness of the risen life is ours as we are called to share at the table of the Eucharist. Christ is risen indeed. Alleluia!



First Reading: (Acts 10:34.37-43). This is part of an early sermon of Peter. Second Reading: (Col 3:1-4). Through our Baptism we already share in the risen life of Christ, though in a hidden and mysterious way.

Gospel: (In 20:1-9). On discovering the empty tomb, the disciples begin to grasp what the Scriptures had foretold, namely, that he would rise from the dead.

THOUGHT FOR 2nd SUNDAY OF EASTER (6/7th April): There is a bit of Thomas in all of us. By human standards it is asking too much to believe that a dead man has come back to life after three days. But what Jesus is saying is that if we allow ourselves to experience the power of his resurrection, then we too can never die.



First Reading: (Acts 4:32-35). This reading gives us a picture of how the first Christians lived community.

Second Reading: (1 John 5:1-6). Christians are children of God and show their love for God by keeping His commandments.

Gospel: (Jn 20:19-31). St John's account of how Thomas' doubt turned into faith.


